Can I?

Treat your current practice as an office practice

- Access management
- Patient selection
- Equipment and materials
- Management of complications
- Sedation/anesthesia



Will they let me?

- State requirements
- Accreditation
- Radiation safety
- Local zoning
- Malpractice
- ASC vs. OIS

Can I afford it?

How much will it cost/how will I pay for it?

- Lease or rent
 - -Physical plant
 - -Imaging equipment
 - -Monitors
- Consign
 - Disposable endovascular equipment



• Buy

 All the extras; stretchers, gauze pads IV equipment meds etc etc.

Financial

- How will you get paid?
 - Facility vs Non-facility fees
 - Look at your existing practice
 - Be realistic
 - An OIS is a great place to care for your patients, not a way to attract them.
 - Give yourself room to grow slowly

Where?

- Expand your office or move?
- Share space?
- Proximity to a hospital
- Accreditation requirements
- Local and state regs
- Work with an experienced commercial contractor



Where?

What you need

- "self contained"
- Procedure room
- Pre and post op area
- Nursing work area
- Waiting room
- Storage
- Clean/dirty utility area







Who?

- Staff are the lifeblood of your facility
- Network: They are out there already
- Identify a director(s)
- Don't understaff
 - Appropriate skill level
 - Appropriate number
- Most can be per diem or part time



Who do you need?

- Nursing (CVICU or Cath Recovery)
 - Head nurse: schedule, protocols, QA, equipment, education, ensure pre op testing etc.
- Rad techs

Head RT: schedule, inventory, interface with industry, radiation safety

- Scrub tech (could be RT)
- Anesthesia
- Other office staff
 - Booking and clerical
 - Revenue cycle management; Billing and coding etc
 - Office nursing
 - Vascular lab
 - Office manager

With What?

- Find industry partners
- Imaging
 - Most companies have financing
 - Have partnerships with other suppliers: table, injector, ultrasound etc.



With What?

- Endovascular equipment
 Work with established people....relationships matter...
 - Equipment lists
 - Consignment
 - Inventory management
 - Make sure you have what you need...emergencies etc.



General

- Visit other facilities
- Pick good industry partners
- Pick good staff and empower them
